For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, pardon us of all that is past & may we serve you always in newness of life, to the glory of your holy name; through Jesus Christ our Lord, AMEN.

THE PARDON: (Leader) In the name of Jesus Christ you are forgiven.

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING: The Lord be with you. And with your spirit. Lift up your hearts. We lift them up to the Lord. Let us give our thanks to the Lord our God. It is right & good to give him thanks & praise.

It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you Almighty God, creator of heaven and earth. And so, with your people on earth and all the company of heaven we praise your name and join their unending hymn:

Holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION: Holy are you, and blessed is your Son Jesus Christ. When we had turned aside from your gifts, you gave us, in him, your crowning gift. Let us join together with all the saints, proclaiming the mystery of the faith:

Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again.

Pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered here and on these gifts of bread and wine. Make them be for us the body and blood of Christ, that we may be for the world the body of Christ, redeemed by his blood. By your Spirit make us one with Christ, one with each other, and one in ministry to all the world, until Christ comes in final victory, and we feast at his heavenly banquet. Through your Son Jesus Christ, with your Holy Spirit in your holy Church, all honor and glory is yours almighty God, mow and forever. Amen.
